

# KMOU Incoming General Exchange Program (2022 Fall & 2023 Spring, Undergraduate)

KMOU Incoming Exchange Program is for KMOU partner universities' students who wish to study at KMOU for one or two semesters and transfer credits to their home university. To be an exchange student, candidates must be officially nominated and pay the tuition fee to their home university.

## Study Period

- ① 2022 Fall : September 2022 to February 2023
  - ② 2022 Fall & 2023 Spring : September 2022 to August 2023
- ※ Students must select one period between ① and ②.

## Number of Students

It is depending on each MOU or MOA with the KMOU partner universities.

## Qualification

- ① Applicants must be enrolled in at least second semester at their home university.
- ② CGPA is 2.91/4.5(equivalent to 2.8/4.3 or 2.64/4.0) or above  
※ Percentile rank is 80/100 or above
- ③ Korean or English language proficiency is highly recommended enough to take lectures.
- ④ Applicants must be sound in physically and mentally during their study at KMOU
- ⑤ Applicants must complete overseas vaccinations on COVID-19

## Academics

Applicants must choose one academic department considering their academic background or study abroad purpose. However, students will be able to any courses with a permission from different colleges and departments.

## Application Schedule

- ① Application Deadline : May 13(Friday), 2022
- ② Result Announcement : Late May, 2022
- ③ Acceptance Package : Early or Middle June, 2022

## Document to be submitted

- ① Application form 『Form 2-A』
  - ② Nomination letter by the home university
  - ③ Certificate of Enrollment
  - ④ Official Academic Transcript
  - ⑤ State of Purpose 『Form 2-B』
  - ⑥ Passport Copy in Valid(including study period at KMOU)
  - ⑦ ID photo file sized by 3.5×4.5cm
  - ⑧ COVID-19 vaccination history 『Form 2-C』
- ※ All documents must be written in English or Korean

### > (GKS) Scholarship period

2022 Fall only

### > (GKS) Qualifications

- ① KMOU's partner university's undergraduate-level students and should be enrolled and completed at least two semesters at their home university
- ② Total CGPA is 80% or above(See the file 3-D, 'Conversion Table')

### > (GKS) Documents to be submitted

- ① Application Form 『Form 3-A』
- ② Certificate of Enrollment : Stated a student's address
- ③ Official Academic Transcript  
※ Covert CGPA to a percentage. If not, we cannot accept it.
- ④ Study Plan 『Form 3-B』
- ⑤ Personal Statement 『Form 3-C』
- ⑥ Letter of Recommendation by a professor of the home university
- ⑦ Passport Copy in Valid(including study period at KMOU)
- ⑧ Certificate of English or Korean language test results(Optional)  
- TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC, CFER, CET-6, TOPIK etc.

### > (GKS) Scholarship

- ① Settlement Allowance : KRW 200,000 upon arrival
- ② Living Expenses : KRW 500,000 per month
- ③ Round-trip Airfare : Reimbursement available within the set amount
- ④ National Health Insurance Fees during stay in Korea

NOTE 1) It is not guarantee for all applicants. The final decision will be made by the Korean Ministry of Education.

NOTE 2) GKS applicants must submit the above documents additionally.

## Accommodation

Incoming exchange students are given priority for entering the university's dormitory, however, note we cannot guarantee.
